

Mapping of open science policies in Nordics and Baltics



- All countries in a transition towards Open Science at different stages
- Stakeholder involvement varies
- Access policies to data and RI needs to be coupled to e-infra resource provisioning

Legal aspects

• Cross-border sharing of sensitive data – a policy issue more than a legal issue

Landscape survey results on Policies



- 106 respondents = 50% response rate But differs a lot on individual questions
- 80% familiar with FAIR, 50% familiar with EOSC,
- 14 out of 15 funding bodies has rules on open access for their grants, 8 impose rules on open research data
- Half of HEIs, RIs and e-infrastructures have open access policies and/or open research data policy (varies according to grants)
- Only few organisations have informal guidelines towards FAIR, only a very small fraction have formal rules and framework.

In general – not strong coupling between Open Science policy and tangible guidelines for scientific practise
